

UPDATE ON DESMOND FATALITY INQUIRY PROCEEDINGS

Friday, Oct. 29, 2021 (Halifax, NS) – The Desmond Fatality Inquiry will resume evidentiary hearings at the courthouse in Port Hawkesbury, N.S., at 9:30 a.m. on Monday, Nov. 1. The proceedings are expected to continue until Friday, Nov. 5.

Please note that due to physical distancing requirements, in-person access to the Inquiry hearing room continues to be restricted. Anyone not essential to the proceedings must get advance permission from Judge Zimmer to attend in person. Anyone attending the Inquiry proceedings in person will be required to wear a disposable medical mask.

To maintain the open courts principle, members of the media will be permitted to attend the proceedings in person, if there is space available in the hearing room. Unless otherwise ordered by the judge, the proceedings will also be livestreamed on the [Inquiry website](#).

At the conclusion of the proceedings later this year, Judge Zimmer is expected to finalize his written report containing his findings and recommendations, as per the Terms of Reference outlined in the [Inquiry Mandate](#).
